## Open-Ended (Short Answer)

[10] Q. Who was king Laban?

*A. King Laban was a wicked king who lived in Jerusalem. He stored the record of the Jews, written on brass plates. Laman, Lemuel, Nephi, and Sam (Lehi's sons) were told to leave the wilderness, and go back to Jerusalem and get the sacred records from King Laban. Nephi obeyed the commandment, and by divine circumstances obtained the brass plates from King Laban.*

[20] Q. What was the Liahona?

*A. The Liahona was brass ball of curious workmanship. The Lord gave it to Lehi in the wilderness. On it, there were pointers (arrows), and a place where words would appear. The Liahona guided Lehi and his family through the wilderness, across the sea, and to the promised land. However, the pointers gave the correct travel of direction only when the people were obeying the commandments.*

[30] Q. Why is it called, "The Book of Mormon"?

*A. Mormon was a prophet who had preserved the plates of Nephi. The plates of Nephi contained a record of history and spiritual importance since Lehi's departure from Jerusalem. Mormon abridged, condensed, and told in his own words all of the best parts of the history and spiritual truths found in the records and testimonies of the many Book of Mormon prophets who had lived before him.*

[40] Q. How do you receive a testimony of the Book of Mormon?

*A. Moroni counsels us who have read the Book of Mormon to ponder in our hearts the words. Then we must pray with a sincere heart, with real intent, having faith in Christ to Heavenly Father. Heavenly Father will manifest to us the truth of the Book of Mormon, by the power of the Holy Ghost.*

[50] Q. What is a witness?

*A. A witness testifies of truthfulness. The Lord teaches that there must be at least two witnesses. The Bible testifies of Jesus Christ, and the Book of Mormon testifies of Jesus Christ. Two books of scripture from different lands witness that Jesus is the Christ. In modern history, three separate individuals were blessed by the Lord to have actually seen an angel of God and the gold plates, and their ancient engravings. In the Book of Mormon preface pages, Oliver Cowdery, David Whitmer, and Martin Harris bear testimony of their experience, and are witnesses.*

# Book of Mormon Jeopardy

1. Divide the class into two or more equal teams.
2. The colored points cards are posted on the Jeopardy board in front of the teams. Questions are correlated to the colored points cards. The questions are derived from Book of Mormon stories. The point value represents the difficulty of the questions.
3. Each color category (red, blue, orange, green) represents a type of question. Question types include: True or False; Fill in the Blank; Multiple Choice; and Open-Ended (Short Answer).
4. Teams will take turns selecting colored points cards. If the team cannot answer the question, either the question may given to a different team to earn the points; or the points can become a negative on the playing team's score.
5. Each team will keep track of points, according to the questions they select.
6. Each class member will receive a prize if they participate, and with the help of the other team(s), complete the Jeopardy board by removing the colored points cards and answering all of the questions. Points will be kept, for the sake of competition, but everyone will be a winner.
